Things to see in Tarragona



Metropol Theatre

This theatre was built in 1908. It puts on plays, shows and concerts. It is on *Rambla Nova*.



Modern Art Museum

This Museum and Art Gallery is on *Carrer de Santa Anna*.



The Port of Tarragona Museum

This museum tells you about the history of the port and docks, from roman times to today.

It is on *Moll de la Costa*.



Tarragona Train Station

It is located near the seaside.



Roman Amphitheatre

In the Roman times, this is where they came to see popular shows like fights between gladiators. It is at *Parc de l'amfiteatre*.



Bóveda del Pallol

At *Plaça del Pallol*. This old building is about 600 years old.



Casa Canals

Casa Canals or Canals house is one of the few stately homes that still exist in Tarragona.


It is about 600 years old. It can be visited by appointment only for groups. To reserve: 977 244 22 20

Tarragona Cathedral

The Cathedral is at *Plaça Pla de la Seu*



It is built on the remains of an old Roman Temple.

Parts of the cathedral is 2000 years old. But much of it is about 800 years old.



It has cloisters that you can look around.

Roman Circus

This is where the Romans used to hold horse and chariot races. It is on *Rambla Vella*.



It would hold over 30,000 people.

It was built about 2000 years ago.

Roman Walls

About 2000 years ago, the Romans built a great wall that went around the city.



These are the oldest Roman walls that you can see anywhere in the world except in Italy.
